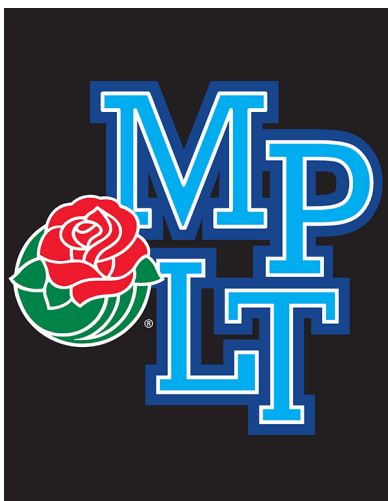

### **12:30pm Farmer's Market**

Launched in 1934, Farmers Market became the central meeting place for Angelenos. Today, "Meet me at 3rd and Fairfax" is one of the most common phrases in southern California. According to the L.A. Times, Farmers Market is the #1 place in L.A. to spot celebrities! The market features nearly 100 shops and eateries and its 1941 clock tower is now a world-famous icon. Meal money will be provided for lunch here today.

### **2:30pm Guided Tour of Hollywood**

Visit Olvera Street, the Mexican marketplace located in one of the oldest streets in Los Angeles. Drive through the posh Beverly Hills and Bel-Air Estates areas to get a glimpse of the homes of some of Hollywood's stars. Continue along famous Rodeo Drive where beautiful mansions and exclusive shops showcase the lifestyles of the rich and famous. See Mann's Chinese Theater where stars' hands or footprints have been immortalized. Some have imprinted their trademarks (John Wayne's fist and Jimmy Durante's nose) while others have left personal messages. The Hollywood Bowl and Sunset Strip are featured as well.

# General Information

---

As an approved school trip, all school and organization rules and policies set forth in the student handbook are in effect for the duration of this trip.

## GROUP TRAVEL HINTS

1. You are representing your school & community. Dress appropriately.
2. Good manners are always a plus wherever you are!
3. Communicate with your chaperones; let them know where you are.
4. If you feel ill, tell your chaperone immediately.
5. Review your itinerary and be aware of your responsibilities.
6. It takes time to move a large group. Be patient. Arrive on time.
7. Eat properly & sleep at night.

## MOTOR COACH INSTRUCTIONS

1. Do not leave personal items on the coach overnight.
2. Food may be taken on board as long as the coach is kept clean. Drinks should be in plastic screw-top bottles.
3. Please treat your driver with respect.
4. Never flush foreign objects in the toilet! Once the chemical flush is full, it is unusable; use rest stops when possible.
5. Do not disembark until your escort or director releases you.
6. Please, NO Flash Photography while on board the motor coach!
7. Please remain seated while vehicle is in motion.

## HOTEL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Read the instructions in your room concerning an emergency escape.
2. At curfew, you must be in your room. No one is to enter your room after curfew except chaperones or staff. Keep the noise level down.
3. Elevators are for *all* hotel guests; respect the other guests.
4. Telephones must not be used after curfew except in an emergency. You are responsible for outside phone charges to your room.
5. Keep your room locked! Keep track of the key.
6. No student is allowed in the room of a person of the opposite sex.

## RESPONSIBILITIES OF CHAPERONES

1. This tour is designed for students. Be patient, flexible, and helpful.
2. Make sure everyone understands all instructions.
3. Communicate-get to know the students by name.
4. Make sure hotel rooms are in order upon arrival and departure.
5. Monitor rooms at curfew. The after-hour rule must be enforced.
6. Make sure your students are up each morning on time.
7. Report any rule violations to the director; but don't create problems.
8. Be courteous and helpful; correct if necessary, but don't antagonize.
9. You cannot grant a favor for one unless you can do it for everyone!
10. BE PATIENT-DON'T LOSE YOUR SENSE OF HUMOR!

## WHAT TO PACK

1. Toiletries and medications. Do not pack medication-keep it on your person. Take a written prescription in case you lose your medication.

3. Hairdryer, alarm clock. Use the buddy system. Only one is needed.

# Pasadena, CA

---

## **PASADENA**

Nestled at the base of the San Gabriel Mountains, 11 miles northeast of downtown Los Angeles, Pasadena is best known for the annual Tournament of Roses Parade and Rose Bowl Football Game. Part of an original Mexican land grant, Pasadena was first called, Indiana Colony, after an early settler, Dr. Daniel M. Berry of Indiana. The name changed to Pasadena in 1986 when the town became the second incorporated municipality in Los Angeles County. With a current population approaching 150,000, the town boasts several historic landmarks and three distinctive districts that attract visitors to its signature California architecture, arts, culture, dining, outdoor pursuits and shopping. Its sunny Mediterranean climate is a big part of its appeal. The Huntington Library, Art Collections and Botanical Gardens, and the Norton Simon Museum hold just a few of the treasures to be found in this vibrant, active community.

## **TOURNAMENT OF ROSES HISTORY**

The Valley Hunt Club came up with an idea in 1890 to use the Pasadena area's great climate to attract visitors to a mid-winter holiday, including games, contests and outdoor activity. They added a parade featuring beautiful and plentiful flowers to kick-off the festival, and a time-honored and much-loved tradition was born. The Tournament of Roses Association was formed in 1895, and in 1902, a football game between Stanford University and the University of Michigan was added (U-M rolled, 49 – 0!). The stadium, quickly named, The Rose Bowl, came along in 1923, and the parade has become the largest and most elaborate parade in the USA, if not in the world. Ingenious, beautiful floats, sponsored by companies and organizations, marching bands, equestrian units and that famous California sunshine attract millions of television viewers for several hours each year on New Year's Day (or Jan. 2, if New Year's is on a Sunday)!

## **TOURNAMENT OF ROSES PARADE**

This world-famous 5.5-mile parade of beauty takes place along Pasadena's Colorado Boulevard. The parade features bands from throughout the country and some of the most spectacular floats imaginable! This is a favorite for millions who set time aside every year to view this nationally televised event.

## **PERSONAL SECURITY - CALIFORNIA**

Tourist and commercial areas in California are very crowded. especially theme parks, and people walk very fast. Vehicles move quickly, and drive very close to the curbs. Please be alert, and pay attention to what's going on around you. Here's some more tips:

1. Make sure you are always with at least three persons from our group. You are to never be totally alone.
2. Keep a firm grip on all belongings; keep wallets in front pockets.
3. Be very cautious about striking up conversations with strangers. If someone repeatedly annoys you, tell your chaperone.
4. Don't flaunt wealth. Leave expensive jewelry & watches home.
5. Exercise some "Street Sense." Think for yourself. Use good judgment. Be aware of unusual or suspicious behavior. If it doesn't feel right, it probably isn't right.

# Air Travel Information

---

## **ID REQUIREMENTS - *Travel Within the USA***

- ◆ Persons 18 yrs. & older must carry a valid government-issued photo ID (driver's license or passport).
- ◆ Persons 17 yrs. & younger should have a school photo ID or license.

## **ID REQUIREMENTS - *International Travel***

- ◆ U.S. Citizens: Carry a U.S. Passport, valid 6 months after trip's end.
- ◆ Non-U.S. Citizens: Carry a valid foreign passport with re-entry permit and/or visa to USA; may need visa from destination countries.

## **LUGGAGE TAGS**

Write name & address on tags provided and attach them to checked and carry-on luggage. Also, tape name & address inside all bags.

## **CARRY-ON BAGGAGE**

Limit is 1 carry-on bag, plus 1 briefcase or purse or camera bag. Neither may exceed size & weight listed in itinerary. The 2 pieces must fit under the seat or in the overhead compartment. Bags may be searched often. See airline's web site for its policies. Important: Transportation Security Administration's (TSA) 3-1-1 Rule limits carry-on liquid items: liquids, gels and aerosols must be in 3-oz. or smaller containers, all put inside 1 clear, 1-quart, zip-top bag.

## **CHECKED BAGGAGE**

Tour limit is 1 checked bag, within itinerary size & weight limits. Bag must be *unlocked*, unless lock is a TSA "Accepted and Recognized Lock." If not, TSA will break the lock to inspect the bag. Don't put travel documents, keys, currency, jewelry, medicine or irreplaceable articles in checked luggage. Refer to airline's web-site for specific policies.

## **NOT PERMITTED on you or in your Carry-On:**

- ◆ Any sharp, pointed or cutting instrument (knives, pointed scissors, etc.)
- ◆ Anything that can be a weapon (bat, golf club, tools, toy/real gun, etc.)
- ◆ Ammo, chemicals, explosives, lighter fluid, strike-anywhere matches.
- ◆ Liquids (lotions, perfumes, etc., except 3-1-1 Rule items in a clear bag).

## **PLANNING AHEAD & SECURITY CHECK**

- ◆ Give medical and emergency contact information to the Group Leader.
- ◆ Bring Tour Booklet. Leave a copy of the Tour Itinerary at home.
- ◆ Do not pack film in a suitcase. Strong luggage scanners ruin film. Hand-carry film. You may ask Security to hand-inspect it.
- ◆ Have NO "Not Permitted" items with you. At the Security Checkpoint, place shoes & belt buckles & all metal objects (coins, watch, cell phone) in a security bin to be scanned. Place 3-1-1 Rule zip-top bag from carry-on in the bin, too. Beverages may not be taken through Security.
- ◆ **Have passport and/or photo ID on your person on Travel Days.**
- ◆ Be patient & polite. Security lines and security checks may be long.
- ◆ Don't joke about security or try to fool security personnel. Their job is to treat all suspicious persons and behaviors as real threats. If Security takes you into custody, you forfeit all legal rights, you become liable for stiff fines, and you will miss the rest of the trip. See also [www.tsa.gov](http://www.tsa.gov)

## **ABOARD THE AIRCRAFT**

- ◆ Pay attention to aircraft safety features explained by flight attendants.
- ◆ Radios & cell phones may not be operated during flight.
- ◆ Food & beverages must be consumed at your seat. Food and beverages are seldom included on your flight; they may be available to purchase.
- ◆ Aircraft cabin pressure may cause ears to ache or pop. Swallow often or chew gum to end discomfort.
